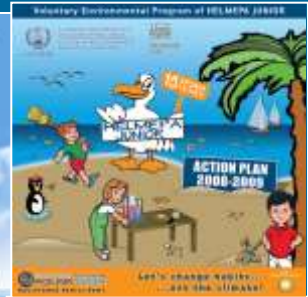

MAIN DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
Entering into force on 1 January 2013

Food waste (comminuted or ground) (except for animal carcasses) in bulk with average particle size less than 25 millimetres	PERMITTED in 100-litre cubic	PERMITTED in 100-litre cubic
Food waste not comminuted or ground	PERMITTED in 12-litre cubic	PROHIBITED
Cargo residues not permitted in small cargo	PERMITTED in 12-litre cubic	PROHIBITED
Cargo residues permitted in small cargo	PERMITTED in 12-litre cubic	PERMITTED in 12-litre cubic
Operating manuals and equipment not permitted to be discharged overboard	PERMITTED	PERMITTED in 100-litre cubic
Operating manuals and equipment not permitted to be discharged overboard	PERMITTED	PERMITTED
Garbage of animals (comminuted) stored in cargo and before being discharged being first stored	PERMITTED in 100-litre cubic at the maximum permitted depth	PROHIBITED
All other garbage (operating, maintenance, etc.) including oil, oil fuel, oil sludge, oily bilge water, oily sewage, paint and other liquids	PROHIBITED	PROHIBITED
