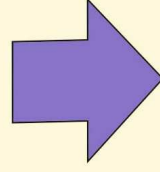

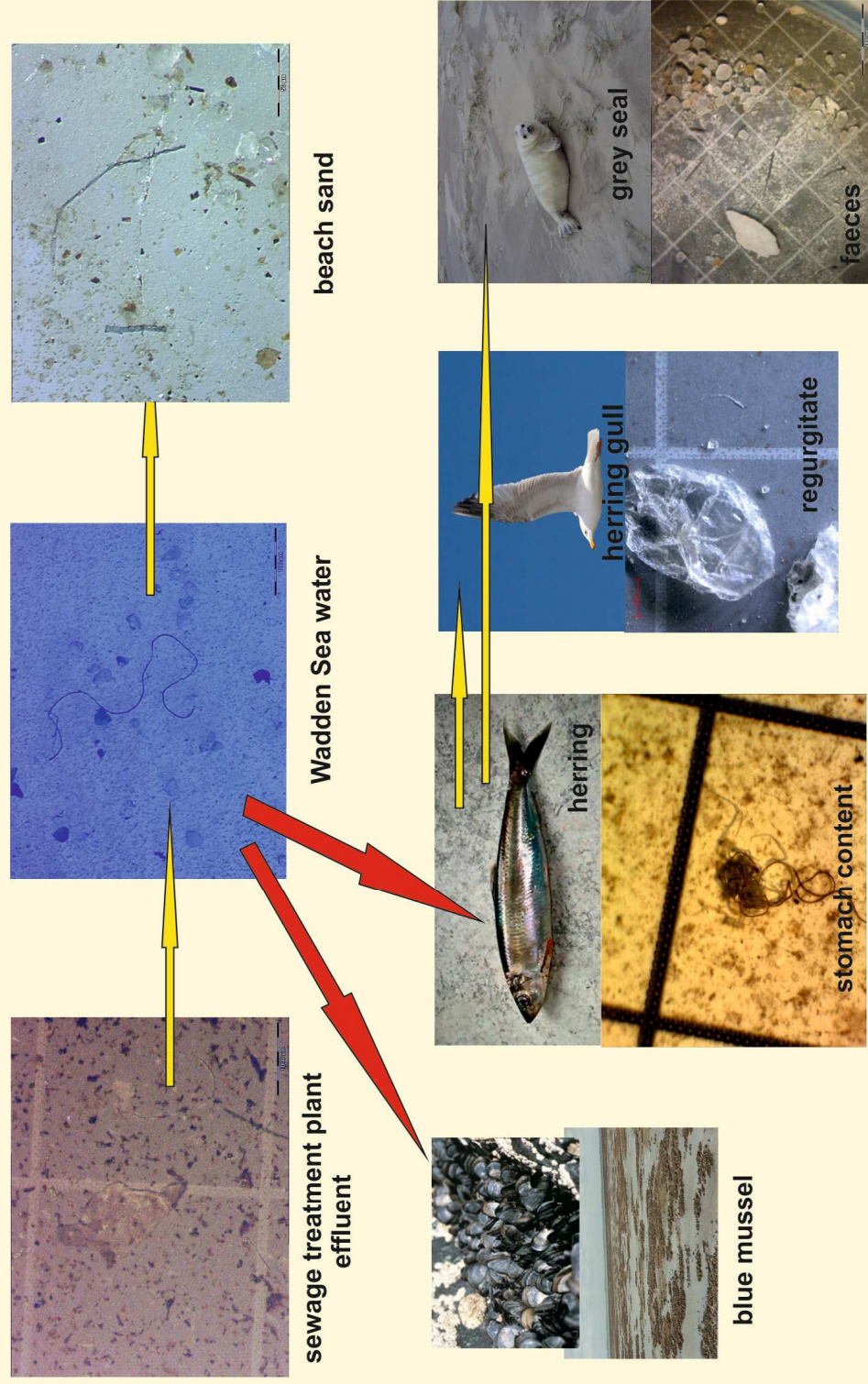

Microplastic, i.e. granular particles, fibres and fragments, occurs ubiquitously in waters, sediments and biota of the Lower Saxonian Wadden Sea.

For seabirds and seals food chain transfer is evident. Whether uptake of microplastic is harmful to the organisms is, however, presently unknown.
